Hands were reaching out for candy. "You came to see us!", one of them yelled, excitedly. I looked into their eyes and smiled. What did I see? I saw love. I saw trust.

Even though we go there often, each time I am still shocked at what we find. Concrete floors. Hunger. Addiction. Hopelessness. Depression. Yet, this is where our children live. This is where they play.

What can we do to help? ThereÕs not much we can do about where they live. Their families are bound by sin and addiction. We can take them food and clothing and minister to their physical needs, but ultimately they need the life-changing message of the Gospel. They need Jesus!

Who will be "Jesus" to Mulberry Street? Who will be "Jesus" to children like Lena? Will I? Will you?
